(Zamboanga) On September 9 the Philippine ferry sank in the southern Philippines with nearly 1000 passengers on board. 9 people were killed and dozens were left missing. The civilian ship MV Myriad helped in the search and rescue with their Hatecke rescue boat. According to the owner, the well maintained boat "implemented a fabulous rescuer".
